**November 14**: **Stamp Lottery** (good quality donations sought from members with Happy Bucks awarded for each donation; members pay \$5 for 20 'lottery' tickets and place one or more tickets in containers in front of each item they want to win; one winning ticket drawn from each container; unsold lots auctioned off at draw's end)

**December 12 (winter hours)**: **Annual Christmas Party, Auction and Elimination Draw**Complete turkey dinner served (paid ticket event); members and their guests asked to each donate at least one gift with a value of \$10 for auction; all auction proceeds to the Salvation Army; elimination draw held for excellent prizes (to be announced)

March 27: Guest Dealer Wes Eardley; Freebie Night (members invited to display stamp-related items they're willing to part with for free)

**April 10: Dutch Auction** (unlimited lots for sale per person at starting price of \$10 per item; during auction price of each item drops in \$1 increments until item is sold; judging of members' "One Page" and "Anything Goes" exhibits; final KAPEX preparations

**April 24**: **Guest Dealer James McKenzie**; KAPEX Exhibit Awards Presentation and Pizza Party; KAPEX co-chairs Sue Scott and Peter Evelyn provide a summary of KAPEX 2018 and solicit input as to what worked and what didn't and solicit suggestions for next year
