September 11: Guest Dealer Jim Allen.

- Topical Collecting: A few club members to provide insight into their thematic collections with Marie Olver introducing. Happy Dollars are awarded to all presenters.

Stamps of Colour: Members must assemble a page(s) of stamps issued prior to 1965 that are predominantly purple in colour. Sale circuit vouchers of \$10 and \$5 go to the top two entries.

October 9: Guest Dealer Stanley Doktor.

October 23: Fall Auction and Pizza Party.

- Members can put an unlimited number of lots up for sale. Minimum value is \$3 with 10% of the sale price going to the club. Unsold items must be reclaimed by those who submitted them.
- Free Membership Draw. Note that only members who have paid their annual fee are eligible to win.

November 13: Stamp Lottery.

- Good quality donations sought from members with Happy Dollars awarded for each donation.
Members pay \$5 for 15 or \$10 for 40 'lottery tickets' and place one or more tickets in containers in front of each item they want to win. There will be one winning ticket drawn from each container. Unsold lots will be auctioned off at the draw's end. Proceeds from lottery go to the Salvation Army. One lucky person will win a \$250 (approximate) tax receipt from the Salvation Army for the Club's lottery proceeds donation.
