ARTICLES OF CONTINUANCE OF THE ROYAL PHILATELIC SOCIETY OF CANADA

SCHEDULE A

The purposes of the Corporation are:

- (a) to encourage and promote the science of philately by the acquirement and study of stamps;
- (b) to cultivate fraternal relations and mutual friendship among philatelists;
- (c) to encourage and assist new collectors and to foster the interest of youth in the subject
- (d) to assist local clubs and societies whenever possible;
- (e) to promote stamp exhibitions, displays and shows which tend to advance the status of the hobby;
- (f) to assist members in acquiring and disposing of stamps both individually and through the departments provided;
- (g) to discover and supress the purchase, sale and exchange of forgeries and unauthorized issues of stamps;
- (h) to stimulate and advance affiliations between collectors and kindred organizations in the British Empire and Foreign countries;
- (i) to demonstrate the fact that philately is an educational, serious and entertaining pursuit; and
- (j) to represent stamp collecting interests generally as a national organization.
