## ROYAL TOUR COVERS - 1951

#### BY EUGENE BARNA

During the past year, there has been considerable interest shown in the covers mailed aboard the Royal Train during the tour of the then Princess Elizabeth and her husband, Philip, Duke of Edinburgh, in October and November of 1951.

Since then, I have waited for someone to write an account on these Royal Train Covers. On seeing that very little mention of them was made in the Philatelic press, I decided to endeavour to make a survey of the number in the hands of philatelists. Although my survey is far from complete, I am giving this account with the hope that I will hear from other collectors who possess such covers.

Many sent covers to the Postmaster of the Royal Train but as a rule they were returned to the sender with the following note from the Post office Dept. "Dear Sir or Madam:

NO FACILITIES FOR PHILATELIC MAIL ON ROYAL TRAIN

The stamped addressed envelope (s) or post card (s) you forwarded to the Postmaster or Railway Post Office Clerk at \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ is/are returned herewith, uncancelled.

It is regretted that the Royal Train does not possess facilities for servicing philatelic mail and the Postmasters are not permitted to cancel mail received addressed to themselves.

> (Signed) Director of Financial Services, P.O.D."

When I started the survey, I wrote to the Director of Financial Services asking for further information and for samples of cancellations used on the Royal Train. Following is the reply I received.

"The Royal Train Post Office was

Authorized as second class mail by The Post Office Department, Ottawa.

very limited in accommodation and in the number of staff that could serve this Office. It was realized that the staff's normal function to provide a complete and expeditious postal service for the Royal Party, the press and security forces and others, would be seriously impaired if the staff was expected to service a very large volume of philatelic covers in addition. For this reason, no philatelic service was authorized or advertised.

It was known at the time of operations of the Royal Train Post Office that many collectors were obtaining cancellation markings by having a member of the traincrew, the Royal Party, press or security forces, post the covers. These items could not be identified or distinguished from normal mail and had to be forwarded to the addressee. It was with much reluctance, however, that the Department found it necessary to refuse to handle all covers that could be identified as philatelic mail, in some cases many hundreds of pieces from individual dealers in order to avoid overtaxing the accommodation and staff of the Royal Train Post Office.

All mail handled on the Royal Train was cancelled by hand-stamp reading in English "Royal Train Post Office Canada" or, while in the Province of Quebec, reading in French "Train Royal Bureau de Poste Canada". No count was kept and, of course, it would be impossible to determine the quantity of pieces handled and also the stamps on these pieces. We are not able to locate any person in the Post Office Department, who has examples of these covers.

The Post Office Department is rather jealous of the integrity of its postage stamp cancellations and these items may only be used on legitimate mail matter with the actual date of their cancellation. For this reason, it will not be possible for me to supply you with examples of the cancellations used on the Royal Train. The Department has been obliged to refuse a very large number of requests of this nature.

No provisions were made for the handling of mail aboard the two Warships, H.M.C.S. Ontario and Crusader. The Royal Party were aboard these two ships for such a short time that it was found satisfactory to handle all of the mail from the Royal Train during the periods that they were embarked. The facsimile of the oval rubber stamp shown in your letter was a "model" date stamp which was used to cancel postage on fragile parcel post matter and also used to date Royal Train Post Office records. A French version of this stamp was also used in the Province of Quebec. There is little doubt that Her

Majesty, Queen Elizabeth II, would have secured "Royal Train Philatelic Covers" through her Secretary.

I received several interesting anecdotes and comments concerning the Royal Train Covers.

Here is what one collector wrote:

"For years I have been connected with the Canadian National Railways, now retired. I was born in Wyoming, Ont., almost 72 years ago, been a collector for almost 60 years. Someone in Canada knowing my former connections with the Canadian National Railways, also that the Royal Train would be handled in part by that Railroad, figured I might get some covers through. They addressed 100 covers to me using a type-writer, but did not show the sender's name and address on the outside, just my name and address at Bloomingdale, Michigan. Evidently they sent them to the Post Office Department at Ottawa, Ont., hoping, that they would arrive on the Royal Train. However, they did not reach the Royal Train, the P.O.D., not having the sender's name sent them to me by registered mail. Now I have one hundred covers all bearing the 4c with no cancellation, no nothing. That is one for the book, I cannot find out who made them up and used my name and address."

Another collector wrote, "I think it is a dirty shame the way they handled this business of covers and the train postmark. There were quite a few on sale in Toronto, I am told; Simpson's had several and let them go at 25c each, where they got them I don't know. There are still some for sale in Toronto at \$1 each. They are on plain envelopes and addressed to someone in the city."

I got one through from the train addressed to me. It was one on which I placed a Royal Visit stamp and I sent it to the Engineer asking for his autograph. However, it was mailed by a baggage agent and has the English postmark 7 XI. The agent who sent me a booklet of the itinerary. I thought it was very decent of him. which I tie in with the '51 Tour as follows:—a cover mailed aboard the H.M.C.S. "Ontario", one from the H.M.C.S. "Crusader" autographed by the Commanding Officer, and one that was carried on the Empress of France, autographed by the Captain, and postmarked on arrival at Quebec City. If the party had travelled by ship as originally planned, this would have been a rather desirable item."

A third philatelist wrote:

I have several good covers from the Royal Tour which are as follows:

1. Cover from the "Empress of France" that was to have brought the Princess over. This is autographed by the Captain who retired after this voyage.

2. Cacheted cover autographed by Captain Jones who flew the B.O.A.C.



By some freak of nature I received two covers with the English postmark and date II XI. These are on Capex covers, one with the 4c Capex stamp and the other with the Royal Visit stamp. I sent these to the Postmaster at St. John's, Newfoundland, asking for the St. John's postmark of the day that the Royal Party would be there. How they ever got on the Royal Train I'll never know for the train wasn't in Newfoundland to my knowledge. I have two or three other covers Stratocruiser "Canopie" from England. It is dated Oct. 9, 1951 at Montreal. ((see picture)

5. Catcheted Royal Train cover dated Oct. 16, 1951.

6. Cacheted cover from H.M.C.S. "Crusader", Oct. 19, 1951. It is stamped with the ship's cancel rectangular box with the following

in three lines—H.M.C.S. Crusader-/-Oct. 19, 1951/ Esquimalt, B.C.

7. Cacheted First Day Cover with a block of 4 of the Royal Visit stamp. Dated at Ottawa, Oct. 26, 1951.

8. Cover from the airplane carrying the Princess in Canada. This was autographed by L.A.C. Stewart, pilot of the plane, and is being held at Ottawa by Postal authorities. They were sent to me for identification.

When these two covers were mailed, someone evidently placed a box or book of matches in each. really spoil the covers completely. It is too bad that this had to happen and I do think that the P.O.D. at Ottawa might have sent them to me.

9. Cacheted cover mailed from Washington on the first day of U.S. visit—Oct. 31.

10. Cover dated Oct. 31, 1951 at Washington. It is stamped with a special cachet which shows 2 flags, names of Princess Elizabeth and the Duke of Edinburgh and the duration of the visit—Oct. 31 - Nov. 2, 1951. (see picture)

11. Cover from the H.M.C.S.



The P.O.D. wrote to try and find out who had placed them there. Of course I did not. Why would I send matches to myself? My guess is that the Captain gave these covers to an airforce man to mail and he put in the matches, either as a joke or as a souvenir. I have written several times to Ottawa to release these two covers but they will not. They want to find out who put the matches in them. I really do not think they ever will find out.

These covers were not cancelled and so have no postmark on them. If they ever do get them, they will be cancelled with the date on which they were sent to me which will Ontario—this ship took the Princess to Newfoundland. It has the ship's cancel on it — rectangular box with the following arranged in three lines

cancel — "Royal Voyage", autographed by the Captain and mailed from Liverpool. (see picture)

Two identical sets of the above covers are known to me. One is owned by Mrs. Maxine Cole of Forrest, Manitoba and the other by her brother, Mr. Burke Simpson, 3926 Point Grey Road, Vancouver, B.C. Incidentally, they are NOT for sale.

There is only one other Royal Tour cover not mentioned above and that is one mailed from the S.S. Empress of Scotland. Royal Train Covers known to me are listed in the table.

If all the information I received is correct, then there are at least 300 Royal Train Covers in the hands of philatelists. Several dealers have estimated that there are as many as 2500 of them. However, it is doubtful if the true number will ever be known.

If anyone has covers of which I have not been informed, it would be appreciated if these people would get in touch with me, stating all

## FAMOUS CANADIAN SCULPTOR EMANUEL HAHN DESIGNS CANADIAN STAMPS

Sometime after the 1951 issue of Canadian stamps, often nicknamed "The Capex Issue," Mr. Emanuel Hahn settled down to work on his own designs for Canadian stamps. The Canadian Postal Authorities had invited artists to submit their suggestions for competition in postage stamp designing along somewhat new lines for pictorial stamps including topical subjects such as animals and industries. Many sketches were submitted. Out of the 700 designs sent in, two were chosen by the department — one by Mr. A. L. Pollock who prepared the artwork for the 1952, 20c Forestry Products stamp - and the other by Emanuel Hahn was an animal stamp showing a Rocky Mountain sheep, sometimes called "The Bighorn."



On Monday, November 3, 1952, Canada issued three new stamps and one of these is a design by Mr. Hahn who chose to illustrate the Canada Goose on a 50c stamp, later changed to a 7c denomination. The original sketch for this new stamp was dated September 29, 1951. Mr. Hahn believes that the Can-

Mr. Hahn believes that the Canada Goose is the only animal with the word, Canada, in its name and considers it internationally associated with Canadian wild life. More than twenty years ago he took the opportunity of studying the Canada Goose when he went to Kingsville, Ontario to Jack Miner's sanctuary where Mr. Kahn helped "Uncle Jack", as he liked to be called, band some Canada Geese during their migration. So little wonder that the sculptor chose the Canada Goose as a Canadian postage stamp design and it is the first one of his to be issued.

The work of designing postage stamps is anything but easy. How does an artist begin his work? Mr. Hahn explains the steps he took with the new 7c stamp depicting the bird in flight. "I suppose that artists follow the lines of creating as a musician uses a theme or a writer follows a plot for his story. The first visible evidence is a small concise sketch with pencil or pen. It is then thrown up in a larger



size — possibly 8" by 10" and the lettering is carefully detailed. I had made a number of notes on the Canada Goose — several models measurements of the bird and careful life-size drawings of the wings and the various groups of feathers. Jack Miner had sent to me a carcass of one Canada Goose which had been found dead in a field and incidentally, this same specimen is among the birds preserved at the Royal Ontario Museum in Toronto, Ontario.

The reduction of a large object in pictorial form to the limited space of a postage stamp requires great skill. Mr. Hahn has an explanation. "In the case of the design of the stamp I had to consider the black and white effect which I think worked out effectively in this stamp." (Artists often refer to "black and white" regardless of the finished printed colour — the stamp is blue). And Mr. Kahn continues "Notice the structural scheme of the



design. The body of the bird follows one diagonal and the wings the other. And there is the stabilizing effect of the horizontal lines in the background and the lettering. A11 this is a very important must in any design." Mr. Hahn said, "One is never quite satisfied with a de-sign and there are other people to consider. I can readily understand the headaches the technical men and engravers get over the little bit of coloured paper with the gum on the back. It is so innocent looking but consider that for a few paltry cents it will carry what may be a very important letter anywhere in the world."



Some time ago in 1952, the Post Office officials planned to have a new portrait of King George VI used on a new series of Canadian stamps. The series, from a plaque by Emanuel Hahn, was nearly ready when the death of His Majesty intervened. The plan called for the engraving of a modelled relief portrait, quite different from those portraits by photography. Can we expect some type of portrait in relief on future stamps of Canada? Time will tell.

## HUNTING FOR CANADIAN VARIETIES

minor variety collection as might also the joint pairs in coils. These joined coils are still found today in our current coil stamps but they are not found so often as they were in the issues of King George V.

The current 2-cent coil is an excellent example of the jump, for these may be found in every 25th stamp. The same stamp in panes offers a host of minor flaws, many of them easy to see. The red cross in the 1952 stamp of Canada appears in all parts of the circle of white and it has been found away to the right on the blue. A regular bird



customer if he particularly wanted that "sheet of stamps you just bought", pointing out the faulty perforating. The deal closed when the original owner handed over the pane to the stamp collector. Then the postmaster started to worry fearing trouble if he did not return the stamps to Ottawa.

Although many collectors consider these stamps damaged copies, which they are, the wide range of varieties adds interest — and sometimes headaches.
