November 24: Stamp Lottery

- Good quality donations sought from members with Happy Dollars awarded for each donation. For a successful and fair lottery, the organizers need the prizes by the October 27nd meeting and they must have at least a \$5.00 RETAIL VALUE.

- Members pay \$5 for 15 or \$10 for 40 'lottery tickets' and place one or more tickets in containers in front of each item they want to win. There will be one winning ticket drawn from each container. Unsold lots will be auctioned off at the draw's end.
