RULES AND REGULATIONS

A. Exhibits

- 1. Each exhibit must be totally owned and prepared by the exhibitor.
- 2. Exhibits will be mounted in frames of 6 standard page sizes.
- 3. Exhibits are limited to a maximum of 10 frames.
- 4. Exhibitors may enter in as many classes as they wish and may enter more than one exhibit in any class.
- 5. Exhibits entered in the wrong class may be reclassified by the Exhibition Committee or Judges.
- 6. Previous KAPEX award winning exhibits may not be shown again competitively unless substantially revised.

Those having won Gold with trophy (except Junior and Novice) should be entered in the Masters Class.

B. Procedures

- 1. Applications must be received on or before March 22nd, 2019.
- 2. A separate entry form is to be completed for each exhibit.

- 4. Exhibits being delivered personally must be received at the Evinrude Centre, 911 Monaghan Road, Peterborough, Ontario by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday April 13, 2019.
- 5. Exhibits from out-of-town must be sent by REGISTERED MAIL to the above noted address by March 22nd, 2019 for mounting in frames. Exhibits will be returned by REGISTERED MAIL at the OWNERS EXPENSE. Please include specific instructions, postage and registration fees.
- 6. Exhibits must not be removed from the exhibition hall before 4:00 p.m. on April 13, 2019.

C. Judging and Awards

- 1. Exhibits may be entered as competitive or non-competitive.
- 2. Each competitive entry will be judged on its own merits and will be given a Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver-Bronze or Bronze ribbon at the discretion of the judges. The Judges' decisions are final!

D. Insurance and Liability

- 1. Exhibitors must make their own arrangements for insurance. Exhibits will be treated with extreme care, but are received, held, exhibited and returned at the owner's risk.
