



KAPEX 2027 RULES & REGULATIONS

Kawartha Stamp Club - Chapter No. 58 of the R.P.S.C.

Exhibits

- > Each exhibit must be totally owned and prepared by the exhibitor.
- > Exhibits will be mounted in frames of 6 standard page sizes.
- > Exhibits are limited to 7 frames.
- > Exhibitors may enter more than 1 exhibit and in any class they wish.
- > To ensure all members who wish to exhibit can do so, the number of exhibits a member can enter may be limited at the Exhibition Committee's discretion.
- > Exhibits deemed to have been entered in the wrong class may be reclassified by the Exhibition Committee or Judge(s).
- > Previous KAPEX award winning exhibits may not be shown again competitively unless substantially revised.

Procedures

- > Entry applications must be received on or before April 3, 2027.
- > A separate entry form must be completed for each exhibit.
- > Entry forms are to be given to the Exhibit Coordinator, Sue Evelyn.
- > Exhibits being delivered personally must be received at the Westdale United Church, 1509 Sherbrooke St., Peterborough by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday April 17, 2027.
- > Exhibits must not be removed from the Exhibition hall before 3:30 on Saturday, April 17, 2027.

Judging and Awards

- > Exhibits may be entered as Competitive or Non-Competitive.
- > Each competitive entry will be judged on its own merits and will be given a Gold, Vermeil, Silver, Silver-Bronze, or Bronze ribbon at the discretion of the Judge(s).
- > The Judge(s) decisions are final.

Insurance & Liability

- > Exhibitors must make their own arrangements for insurance. Exhibits will be treated with extreme care, but are received, held, exhibited and returned at the owner's risk.
- > In case of loss or damage arising from whatever cause, no responsibility shall be attached to the Kawartha Stamp Club, its Officers, the Executive Committee or the Westdale United Church at 1509 Sherbrooke St., Peterborough.
