# ANOTHER 'MEASURED" MOMENT......Jim Measures

## **FANNING ISLAND**

You may recall that I was on a cruise and mailed our club bulletin from Fanning Island in 2004. The stamp used shows the cruise ship and a map showing where Fanning is located in relation to Hawaii. Our Bulletins arrived without any cancellations in most cases and in a few cases they were cancelled in Hawaii.

Fanning hjas never had stamps of their own. The earliest covers that I have seen from Fanning used New Zealand stamps. (That's what got me interested in Fanning Island.) later they were made part of the Gilbert

& Ellis Islands Colony and used G&E stamps,. When that colony was broken up Fanning became part of the Republic of Kiribati, and so it remains.



In the 1920s the people of Fanning Island asked the British Post Office for their own stamps and although proofs were prepared, no Fanning Island stamps were produced.

When I visited, I met some of the residents of Fanning Island—see the

photo I took of a typical family standing in front of their house. I fear for these people as climate change is causing water levels to rise so much that several island s have already had to be evacuated. Prediction are for sea levels to rise 12 fee in the next 50 years and the highest land on Fanning Island was 10 feet above sea levels in 2004. You do the Math! If climate



change continues we may never again be able to visit Fanning or many other beautiful islands around the world.

Where will the people go? Do we Care?

Another oddball that recently crossed my desk.
Anyone have any knowledge of this one?
